 is desirous of providing for the pay-
 ment thereof by an assignment of his property
 and effects for that purpose. Now therefore
 first - the party of the first part in consideration
 of the premises and the sum of one dollar
 to him in hand paid by the party of the second
 part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 has granted bargain sold assigned delivered
 and conveyed and by these presents does
 grant bargain sell assign deliver and
 convey unto the said party of the second
 part his sundry and sundry all and
 singular the estate and property real
 and personal of any kind and nature and
 when ever the same may be of the said
 party of the first part which is held or owned
 by him and more particular described as
 follows to wit: The entire stock of grogery
 and dry goods and all other goods now
 in the store house now occupied by said
 party of the first part in the town of Milton
 of any kind what ever including all
 store fixture also including promissory notes
 bills of exchange bonds mortgages
 book accounts and balances of accounts
 contracts policy of insurance all vested
 rights all ~~in~~ ~~in~~ ~~in~~ and all contingent
 interest and expectancies - that said party
 of the second part shall take possession of all
 the property hereby assigned or intended to be
 and shall in accordance with legal
 usages in such matters with all reasonable
 diligence collect in and recover all and
 singular the said debts due and demands
 of all kinds and with and out of the proceeds
