Whereas at a sale of lands by ^{Trusting} W. J. The lot and improvements on Block 37 in Milton sold as the property of Susan Lewis which such sum was the whole amount of Taxes due and unpaid on said above tract of land for the years a fore said together with the interest and costs due thereon and the charges of such sale and has been paid by the said Joseph Ollinger to the said W. J. Williams Collector of Revenue a fore said.

Now therefore know all men by these presents that the State of Florida in consideration of the sum of money a fore said and the premises and in conformity with Law hath and doth here by give grant and convey the above described tract of lands above described together with the hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Joseph Ollinger and to his heirs and assigns to their sole use and benefit forever.
