

Extending North on the East line of the place now occupied by said A J Lane nine chains and Eighty four links to a light wood post thence due East Six Chains and Twenty two links to the NW corner of the said Fishers place bounded by a light wood post thence South by the West line of said Fishers place to Pub & R.R. Containing Six acres more or less. Also a certain tract or parcel of land purchased by said A J Lane of Frederick Fisher of Jackson County State of Mississippi Situated in said State of Florida and County of Santa Rosa and described as follows as per deed of conveyance from said Fisher to said A J Lane the same dated June 13<sup>th</sup> 1882 To wit: the premises recently occupied by the said Fisher in the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida Contain within a fence surrounding the same Commencing at the public road and running north on a line dividing the said Fishers tract from the place recently occupied by A Collinsworth now occupied by Prof Anderson to a point Thirty feet north; thence due East to the East line of the land owned by the late firm of Marguis & Co. Containing Twelve Acres more or less being the same premises described in a deed from George Marguis and wife to said Fisher dated June 29<sup>th</sup> 1881. The said premises described having been sold and conveyed by said Charles Meidinger & wife to one Smith Lane by deed of conveyance of date December the 5<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1887 and recorded in the Clerk office Santa Rosa County Florida and the same having been conveyed to said Frank B. Leary from said Smith Lane & his wife by deed of conveyance dated 21<sup>st</sup> day of December A.D. 1887.
