It now all men by their presents that the
 Board of Education of Florida under an act
 of the Legislature of the State of Florida entitled
 an act to establish a uniform system of common
 schools and a university approved January 30
 1869 and the present Constitution of said state
 for and in consideration of the sum of one
 dollar and twenty-five cents per acre to
 them in hand paid by Ebenezer S. Skinner
 of the County of Escambia State of Florida
 have granted bargain and sold and do by
 their presents grant bargain sell and convey
 unto the said Ebenezer S. Skinner and his
 heirs and assigns forever the following descri-
 bed Lands To-wit: All of Section Sixteen
 (16) in Township Four (4) north of Range Three (3) N
 west. Containing six hundred forty one and 3/4
 acres and lying and being in the County
 of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida
 To have and to hold the said land unto the
 said Ebenezer S. Skinner and his heirs and
 assigns forever
