described property to wit: My undivided
one half interest in a certain tract or

County State of Florida being Lot Four
(A) in Fractional Section Six (B) Township Ten
(C) Range (30) Third West West said Lot
containing one hundred and forty six
acres more or less. Together with
all and singular the improvements
and appurtenances there unto belonging
or anywise appertaining. To have and
to hold the same unto the said Wiley J. Willi-
ams and to his heirs and assigns in fee
simple forever. And I the said Mary
Henderson do hereby covenant to warrant
and defend the same unto the said Wiley
J. Williams and to his heirs and assigns
against the lawful claims or claims of
any and all persons whomsoever.
