Know all men by these presents that whereas the Circuit Court of the first Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida in a case where in Charles Black and Charles E. Black Copartners under the firm name of Chas Black and Son were plaintiffs and William L. Crigler George P. C. Batchelder and John C. Pook Surviving partners of the firm of Pook Nichols & Co. Batchelder Crigler & Co. Batchelder Crigler and Pook and Thomas Murray & Co. and Richard L. Campbell were defendants.

On the 11th day of August 1875 rendered a decree foreclosing the said defendants and all persons claiming or to claim by through or under them of and forever all right and equity of redemption in and to the following parcel of lands: the same being excepted and described in the Trust Deed - and situated in the Counties of Santa Rosa and Walton in the State of Fla.
