trial of said charge having been heard  
before the county judge of Santa Rosa county  
this day. have given bargain & sold  
& by their presents do give bargain & sell  
unto said Jos Ollinger the following  
personal property to wit: one double wagon  
and 2 Mules described as follows to wit:  
The wagon now owned & used by me in the  
hauling of freight in the town of Milton  
& vicinity and two more mules of bay color  
now owned by me & being the only ones  
now owned & in my possession & now being  
used & driven by me in said wagon  
in the hauling of freight. to have & to hold  
said property unto said Jos Ollinger his  
heirs his executors & administrators & assigns  
to have & to hold, behoof forever. And the  
said Pembow hereby agrees to warrant &  
defend the title to said property unto said  
Ollinger his heirs & assigns forever  
Now the above instrument is intended  
as a mortgage & is given unto said  
Ollinger in order to secure him in  
the payment of two hundred dollars which  
the said Pembow hereby agrees to pay unto  
the said Ollinger in the event said Ollinger  
sustains any loss or liability by reason of said  
bond becoming forfeited and he sustains  
loss liability or damage what ever by reason  
thereof. it being understood that said amount
