To whom these presents shall come Greeting

Whereas at a sale of land by M<sup>r</sup> Williams  
Tax Collector of the County of Santa Rosa at  
Public auction at Milton in the said County  
of Santa Rosa on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May in the  
year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred  
and Eighty seven for the nonpayment of  
the Taxes levied and assessed thereon for the  
years one thousand Eight hundred and  
Eighty Four Five & Six and which remained  
unpaid on the day of such sale together with  
the cost and charge due thereon with the  
following described piece or parcel was  
sold to J<sup>r</sup> Beal who was the best bidder therefor  
for the sum of one dollar and thirty cents  
to wit one half in SE Corner land lying on  
South Boundary line of North half of Lot (3)  
Town Sec 3 Township 1 on Range (28)  
N.W. which such sum was the whole  
amount of the Taxes due and unpaid on  
said tract of land for the years afore said  
together with the interest and costs due  
thereon and the charge of such sale and  
has been paid by the said J<sup>r</sup> Beal to M<sup>r</sup> Williams  
Tax Collector afore said.

Now therefore Know all men by these presents that  
the State of Florida in consideration of the  
sum of money afore said and the premises aforesaid  
in conformity with law hereunto and doth hereby  
give grant and convey the tract of land above  
described together with the hereditaments and appur-  
tenances to the said J<sup>r</sup> Beal and to his heirs and  
assigns to their sole use and benefit forever.

this deed pursuant to and in virtue of the  
authority vested by law and for and on  
behalf of said State and hereunto  
subscribed my name officially and affixed
