Whereas at a Sale of Lands by W. Williams Tax
Collector of the County of Santa Rosa by public auction
at Milton in the said County of Santa Rosa
on the 6th day of June in the year of our Lord
one Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-one
for the nonpayment of the Taxes levied and
assessed thereon for the year one thousand
Eight hundred and Eighty and which remained
unpaid on the day of such sale together
with the Costs and charges due there with
the following described piece or parcel
was sold to Mr. Judge and R. Mayer who
were the best bidder therefor for the sum
of Seventeen Dollars and Sixty-Eight
