of the Town of Milton and its vicinity in  
securing and maintaining a suitable cemetery  
for the burial of the dead and for the further  
consideration of one dollar to me in hand  
paid by the "Benevolent Colored Cemetery Association  
of Milton" an association organized under the  
laws of the state of Florida, the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged and confirmed have  
given granted bargained and sold and by  
these presents do give grant bargain sell  
and convey unto the said Benevolent  
Colored Cemetery Association of Milton to be  
used as a burying ground for colored people  
the following described real estate to-wit:  
that lie acres which is now enclosed by a  
fence made by said Association on the  
N E 1/4 of the S E 1/4 of sec 4 township one north  
Range twenty eight west - To have and to hold  
unto the said Association for the use and purpose  
above mentioned forever - In witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 24  
day of July A.D. 1889
