No. 11998. To all to whom these presents shall come greeting:

Whereas Ebenezer H Skinner of Escambia County Florida has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Ebenezer H Skinner according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands and the acts supplemental thereto for the South west quarter of section twenty-eight in Township four north of Range twenty-nine West of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing one hundred and sixty acres and twenty-six hundredths of an acre according to the official Plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Ebenezer Skinner now known as, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Ebenezer Skinner and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same together with all its rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of what soever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Ebenezer Skinner and to his heirs and assigns forever

In testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City of Washington the third day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Eighty Eight and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and Twelfth
