Skinner of Escambia County Florida has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Emory F. Skinner according to the provision of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" and the Act supplemental thereto for the north east quarter and the north west quarter of Section twenty-eight in Township four north of Range twenty-nine West of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing three hundred and twenty acres and fifty two hundredths of an acre according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Emory F. Skinner. Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided. Have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Emory F. Skinner and to his heirs the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature then unto belonging unto the said Emory F. Skinner and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
