To all to whom these presents shall come, I certify that
 Moses Ebenezer H. Skinner of Escambia County Florida
 has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a
 Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville
 Florida whereby it appears that full payment has
 been made by the said Ebenezer H. Skinner according
 to the provisions of the act of Congress of the
 24th of April 1820, entitled "An act authorizing
 further provisions for the sale of the public
 lands, and the act supplemental thereto
 for the north West quarter of the west west
 quarter, the south half of the south west quar-
 ter, the west East quarter and the east half
 of the south East quarter of section
 thirty four in Township five north of
 range thirty nine west of Tallahassee
 meridian in Florida. Containing three
 hundred and fifty nine acres, and
 fifty four hundredths of an acre.
 According to the official plan of the Survey of
 the said lands, returned to the General Land
 Office by the Surveyor General, which
 said tract has been purchased by the
 said Ebenezer H. Skinner.

Now know ye, that the United States of
 America in consideration of the premises
 and in conformity with the second article
 of Congress in such cases made and
 provided, have given and granted, and
 by these presents do give and grant
 unto the said Ebenezer H. Skinner and to
 his heirs and assigns the said tract
 above described, to have and to hold the
 same together with all the rights, privileges,
 immunities and appurtenances whatsoever
 thereto belonging unto the said
 Ebenezer H. Skinner and to his heirs and assigns
 forever.
