Do all whom these presents shall come, greeting:
Whereas Ebenezer H. Skinner of Escambia County Florida has deposited in the general Land office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that full payment has been paid by the said Ebenezer H. Skinner according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled an act making further provisions for the sale of the public lands and the acts supplementing thereto for the North East quarter and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of section Eighteen and the East half of the North East quarter and the South East quarter of section Thirty in Township Three North of Range Twenty nine West of Tallahassee meridian in Florida, containing four hundred and thirty-nine acres and Eighty-three hundredths of an acre according to the official plot of the Survey of the said land returned to the general Land office by the surveyor general, which said tract has been purchased by the said Ebenezer H. Skinner of America in consideration of the provisions of Congress in such case made, as is provided, herein given and granted, and by these presents to give and grant unto
