To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting
Whereas Ebenezer St. Sturges of Escambia County Florida has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Ebenezer St. Sturges according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an act making further provision for the sale of public lands and the acts supplemental thereto for the South East quarter of the South West quarter and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of section thirty in Township four north of Range twenty nine west of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing eight acres and thirty five hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said General which said tract has been purchased by
