 nine Between W. Green of Bogdad County of Santa
 Rosa State of Florida and L. V. Green his wife party of the
 first part and George Newman party of the second part.
 Whereas the said party of the first part is justly indebted
 to the said party of the second part in the sum of One thousand
 Dollars (\$1000.00) Accrued to be paid by one certain promissory
 note bearing even date here with due August 16th day
 and payable at the Simpson Co Office in Bogdad Fla
 with interest on the 16 day of August in the year of
 One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety.
 Now therefore this indenture intenceth that the
 said party of the first part for the better securing the
 payment of the money afore said with interest thereon
 according to the tenor and effect of the said promissory
 note above mentioned and also in consideration of
 the sum of four dollars to them in hand paid by the
 said party of the second part at the delivery of their present
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
 bargained sold and conveyed and by their presents
 do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
 party his heirs & assigns forever all that certain parcel
 of land situated and being in the Town of Bogdad
 County of Santa Rosa State of Florida to wit: Known
 as Lot Beginning at South westerly corner of the lot
 conveyed by E. E. Simpson to the said Robert by deed May 1st
 1871 being the Easterly corner of main st and a line sepa-
 rating the land of the said Robert from the lot belonging to James
 Butler three northely along the Easterly line of said last
 three hundred & fifty feet three Easterly a long the line
 of said Robert stable lot one hundred feet three South
 and parallel with the line before mentioned Two hundred
 and Eight feet three Northely along the line of main
 street to the place of beginning one hundred and one
