Where as there has been deposited in the ^{Greeting}
General Land Office of the United States a
Certificate of the Register of the Land Office
at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears
that pursuant to the act of Congress
approved 20th May 1862 to secure Homesteads
to actual Settlers on the Public Domain and
the acts supplemental thereto the Claim
of Hull Cobb has been established and
duly consummated in conformity to law
for the Lots numbered one and seven
or the East half of the Northeast quarter
and the East half of the South East quarter
Section thirty Six in Township two North
of Range twenty Eight west of Tallahassee
Meridian in Florida containing one
hundred and sixty acres and fifty
hundredths of an acre according
to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said
land returned to the General Land Office
by the Surveyor General

Now Know ye that there is therefore
granted by the United States unto the said
Hull Cobb the Tract of Land above described
To have and to hold the said tract of Land
with the appurtenances thereto unto the
said Hull Cobb and to his heirs and
assigns forever

be made Patent and the Seal of the General
Land Office to be hereunto affixed
Given under my hand at the City of Washington
the twenty first day of June in the year of
our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
