I know all men by their persons that  
 J. J. W. Gilmore of the said County and State for and  
 in consideration of the sum of four hundred (\$400)  
 dollars to me in hand paid by Virginia V. Dunlap  
 as Executor of the estate of David R. Dunlap deceased  
 Alexander Bloch both of the County of Mobile  
 State of Alabama and R. E. Bolling of the County  
 of Montgomery State of Alabama parties of the  
 second part the receipt of which is hereby  
 acknowledged do hereby grant bargain sell  
 convey and deliver to the said parties of the  
 second part this his and assigns four the  
 following described personal property to-wit:  
 One Gin, Gristmill, Boiler, Engine and all  
 the Machinery now in the mill building  
 in the town of Pollard County of Escambia State  
 of Alabama and being the same property formerly  
 owned by Finlay & Kennedy  
 to have and to hold the same unto the said  
 parties of the second part this his and assigns  
 forever. Provided nevertheless that the said  
 J. J. W. Gilmore shall well and truly pay or cause  
 to be paid at maturity by two certain promissory  
 notes of even date herewith drawn by me, one for  
 the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$150) dollars  
 and payable forty (40) days after date and the  
 other for the sum of two hundred and fifty (\$250)  
 dollars payable one (1) year from date to the  
 order of myself and endorsed by me and both  
 payable at the first National Bank of Mobile  
 Alabama and bearing interest at the rate of  
 Eight (8) per cent per annum from date then  
 this conveyance shall be void, otherwise  
 to be and remain in full force and effect  
 And I do hereby authorize and empower  
 the said parties of the second part or their assigns  
 upon default in the payment of any one of the notes  
 above described or upon any sale or attempt  
 to sell by me of said personal property or any  
 part thereof or to remove said property or any part  
 thereof from said County of Escambia State of Florida  
 or upon any seizure of said property or any part  
 thereof by any process of law then the said
