and this mortgage is foreclosed by said Allinger  
his executor's administrator or assigns then said  
Joseph Strickland agrees to pay unto him or  
them, his or their reasonable attorney's for  
all costs of foreclosure all of which shall be  
included in and covered by said Mortgage as  
well as said advances mentioned. all of which  
is hereby understood & mutually agreed upon
