Know all men by these presents that for and in consideration of the sum of Ninety (\$90<sup>00</sup>) Dollars paid and secured to be paid by Joseph Ollinger to the Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company a Corporation chartered by the State of Florida the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company has granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and convey unto said Joseph Ollinger all the following tracts or parcels of land situated in the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida and described as follows to wit The North half of the South West quarter and the South West quarter of the South West quarter of section Eleven (11) in Township three (3) North of Range Twenty five (25) West containing One hundred and twenty (120) acres more or less to have and to hold unto the said Joseph Ollinger his heirs Executors and assigns forever.

Now therefore in consideration of the premises the said Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad Company hereby warrants and defends the title in and to the aforegranted premises to the said Joseph Ollinger in fee simple forever. And in pursuance of the third section in the Mortgage executed by the said Pensacola & Atlantic Rail Road Company to Edmund D. Randolph and John L. Cadwalader as Trustees dated 1st April 1884 duly acknowledged and recorded the said Randolph and Cadwalader hereby convey all their interest as said Trustees in said land to the said Joseph Ollinger. This deed being as to them a quit claim as Trustees and without warranty of title by them. In testimony whereof the said Pensacola & Atlantic Rail Road Company has made and by authority of a resolution of its Board of Directors signed this instrument by its President and attested the same by carrying the seal of the Company to be affixed by its Secretary and the said Edmund D. Randolph and John L. Cadwalader Trustees etc have presents set their hands and seals on this the Eighth day of February 1890
