Whereas at a sale of Lands by W. J. Williams Tax
Collector of the County of Santa Rosa at Public Auction at
2 o'clock in the said County of Santa Rosa on the 4th day
of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and 85 for the non-payment of the Taxes levied and
assessed thereon for the years one thousand eight
hundred and 82-83-84 and which remained unpaid
on the day of such sale together with costs and charges
due therewith the following described piece or parcel
was sold to W. D. Collins who was the best bidder
therefor for the sum of one dollar and Forty seven
Cents The 7th & 8th Sec 7 & 8, 1st R. 27th
Containing 40 acres which such sum was the
whole amount of Taxes due and unpaid on said
piece or parcel of land for the years aforesaid together
with the interest and costs due thereon and the
charges of such sale and has been paid by the said
