Price Jernigan

E Campdonico

This agreement made and entered into this 5<sup>th</sup> day  
of April A.D. 1890 by & between Price Jernigan and E Campdonico  
of all of said Rose County, Florida

Witnesseth: That Price Jernigan agrees to furnish  
to E Campdonico & Co within the next two (2) years  
from date from lands of the Clear Creek Mill property  
and lands adjacent thereto Fifteen thousand (15000)  
or more good merchantable Saw Logs and to deliver  
the same at the rate of seven hundred (700) logs  
per month (rate permitting) to the Inspector of E Campdonico  
at Magnolia Broom in Black Water River.  
Said Logs to be not under thirteen (13) inches in  
diameter or under fifteen (15) ft in length.  
Said Logs to be taken from lands to which said  
Price Jernigan has good title to take the timber.  
And said Price Jernigan agrees to defend said  
E Campdonico & Co against any claims of the  
United States Government or other parties on account of  
said Logs.

E Campdonico has agreed to receive  
said Logs at Magnolia Broom in accordance  
with terms stated above but it being understood  
that said Logs are not to be considered delivered  
until inspected and measured.

E Campdonico has agreed to pay and said Price  
Jernigan agrees to receive the payment for said Logs  
at the following scale of prices viz:

Logs Fifteen to Eighteen ft average length	50¢
"    Eighteen to Twenty                   "    "	5 1/2 "
"    Twenty ft and upward                   "    "	6 "

It is also mutually understood & agreed between  
the parties to this contract that whereas said E Campdonico  
& Co are or are to enable the said Price Jernigan  
to enter into this contract and procure land from  
which to take said Logs, have advanced to him  
the sum of Five hundred (\$500) dollars in cash the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and has  
furthermore indorsed two (2) certain promissory notes  
for \$500 each executed by said Jernigan to A Schman  
& Co of New Orleans La. payable respectively one & two  
years from date & bearing date April 4<sup>th</sup> 1890  
Said Cash and said notes being in payment for said  
Clear Creek Mill property. The same being fully  
described in deed of conveyance executed on
