To all to whom this presents shall come Greeting

Whereas Wilds Leroy Wittich of Escambia County Florida has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Wilds Leroy Wittich according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1870 entitled "An act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the West half of the north west quarter and the southwest quarter of the north west quarter of section forty in Towns hip three north of Range thirty West of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing one hundred and twenty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the surveyor general which said tract has been purchased by the said Wilds Leroy Wittich.

Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such cases made and provided have given and granted and by this presents do give and grant unto the said Wilds Leroy Wittich and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the same to give with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of what so ever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Wilds Leroy Wittich and to his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America have caused this letter to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed Given under my hand at the City of Washington on the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three and of the independence of the United States the one hundred and fourth
