To Have and to hold the said described property together with all & singular the improvements & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Benjamin Mitchell his heirs & assigns in fee simple forever. And the said J. A. Harrison further more for himself his heirs & assigns covenants to warrant and defend the title of the said described property unto the said Mitchell his heirs & assigns against the lawful claims & demands of any and all persons whomsoever.
