To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting;

W.H. Skinner

Whereas Ebenezer H. Skinner of Escambia County Florida has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears the Full Payment has been made by the said Ebenezer H. Skinner according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands and the acts supplemental thereto for the North East quarter of Section twenty in Township three North of Range twenty nine West of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and sixty six hundredths of an acre according to the official Plat of the survey of the said section to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract has been purchased by the said Ebenezer H. Skinner.

Now Know Ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such cases made and provided. Have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Ebenezer H. Skinner and to his heirs the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same together with the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of what soever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Ebenezer H. Skinner and to his heirs and assigns forever In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the twenty Eighth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fourth
