To all to whom these presents shall come greeting
 Homestead Certificate No. 6741 Whereas there has been deposited
 application 18323 in the General Land Office of the
 United States a certificate of the Register of the Land
 Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that
 pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1828
 To cause Homesteads to be actual settling on the Public
 Domain and the acts supplementary thereto the Class
 of Ambrose H. Sutton has been established and duly con-
 firmated in conformity to law for the South half of the
 South West quarter and the South half of the South East
 quarter of section Twenty-one in Township two
 North West of Range Twenty Eight West of Tullahoma
 meridian in Florida containing one hundred and
 fifty nine acres and ninety six hundredths of an acre
 according to the official plat of the Survey of the said
 land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor
 General; Now Know Ye, that there as therefore
 granted by the United States unto the said Ambrose
 Sutton the tract of Land above described: To have and
 to hold the said tract of Land with its appurtenances hereof
 unto the said Ambrose Sutton and to his heirs
 and assigns forever In testimony whereof I
 Benjamin Harrison President of the United States
 of America have caused these letters to be printed
 and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
 Given under my hand and the Seal of the City of Washington the
 twenty first day of January in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and ninety and of the Independence
 of the United States the one hundred and forty sixth
