To All Whom These Presents Shall Come - Greeting
Whereas at a Sale of Land by W. J. Williams Tax Collector of
Santa Rosa on the 3rd day of June in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and 89 for the nonpayment of Taxes
levied and assessed thereon for the year one thousand eight hundred and
Eighty-Eight and which remained unpaid on the day of such sale
together with the costs and charges due thereon the following
piece or parcel was sold to Simpson who was the best
bidder thereof for the sum of One Dollar and thirty five
Cents to wit: The W. J. Williams Section 11 Sp. 54. Re 25 W
which such sum was the whole amount of the Taxes due
and unpaid on said tract of Land for the year aforesaid together
with the interest and costs due thereon and the charges of such
sale and has been paid by the said Simpson to
W. J. Williams Tax Collector aforesaid

Now Therefore Know All Men by these Presents that the State of
Florida in consideration of the sum of money aforesaid and the
promises and in conformity with her national debt hereby give grant
and convey the said tract of Land above described together with
the tenements and appurtenances to the said Simpson
and to their heirs and assigns to their sole use and benefit forever
