To all whom these presents shall come - Greeting -
Whereas at a sale of land by N. J. Williams Tax Collector of
the County of Santa Rosa, at Public auction at Millin
in the said County of Santa Rosa on the 30th day of
June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred
and 89 for the non payment of Taxes levied and assessed
thereon for the year one thousand Eight Hundred and
Eighty Eight and which remained unpaid on the day
of such sale together with the costs and charges due
therewith the following described piece or parcel of
real estate in Simpson Co who was the best
bidder therefor for the sum of One Dollar and Seventy
Five Cents: To wit: The East East Quarter of Section
One (1) in Township Six (6) of Range Twenty four (24)
