this presents do give grant bargain & sell unto
the said Yeoman Davison the following personal
property described as follows: To-wit: One Boiler
(of a twenty horse power) one engine (of ten horse power)
one Brick Machine (of the Patent Patent) all of said
property being now in my possession in the County
of Santa Rosa State of Florida and at my place
commonly known as the Slaybards place
To Have and to hold said property unto the said
Yeoman Davison his Executors Administrators
& assigns to their use & behoof forever.

And the above instrument is intended as a
mortgage and is given unto the said Yeoman
Davison in order the better to secure him in
the payment of the sum of (\$300.00) Three hundred dollars
loaned from him to me for which I have this
day executed unto him my certain promissory note
for said amount payable twelve months after
date with (10%) ten per cent interest from date per
annum. The condition of said mortgage are that
that if the said John F. Kehov shall well & truly pay
said note with interest when the same shall have
become due then the obligation to be null void
else to be of full force & virtue.
