Registry of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida a Certificate of the  
said General Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears  
that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862. To  
secure Homesites to actual Settlers on the Public Domain and the acts  
supplemental thereto, the claim of Thomas B. Brasher has been  
established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the West  
half of the South West quarter of section four in Township one North of Range  
Twenty Eight West of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing seventy three  
acres and thirty four hundredths of an acre according to the official  
Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by  
the Surveyor General;

Now know Ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto  
the said Thomas B. Brasher the tract of Land above described;  
To have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof  
unto the said Thomas B. Brasher and to his heirs and assigns forever  
In testimony whereof I Benjamin Harrison President  
of the United States of America have caused these letters to be  
made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be  
hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand and seal at the City of Washington the  
fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and ninety and of the Independence of  
the United States the one hundred and fourteenth
