 This Indenture made the second day of January in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty between
 Henry Ahrens of the first part and Charles Lee Barron
 of the second part witnesses that the said party of the first
 part for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand
 Dollars of good and lawful money of the United States to
 me in hand paid by the said party of the second part the
 receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged
 have bargained granted sold and confirmed and by
 their presents do grant bargain sell and confirm
 unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs
 and assigns forever. Lot No 333 on Intendencia
 Street, 3/4 of lot No 167 Corner of Adams & Intendencia
 streets. The East half of Arpen lot No 2 with magazine -
 The NW 1/4 & SE 1/4 of Fontinal tract. The East half of lot
 10 of Range 29 30 & 31 bring about 67 1/4 acres more or less
 on St Rosa Sound. All the lands lots improvements &c
 purchased by Keyor Lee Barron of Thos M Daniel in Alabama,
 except the lot of ground on which the saw mill stood.
 The West half of lot 4 sect 33 Town 2 south Range 30 and
 bring about 72 1/2 acres - Two acres in the Pines tract
 Nos 11 & 17. The above lands and lots being situated
 in Escambia County & City of Pensacola, with the exception
 of the grounds near Montezuma
 together with all and singular the hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise
 appertaining and the reversion and reversions remain-
 and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and also all the
 estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever of the
 said party of the first part unto in law or equity of in and to the
 above bargained premises with the said hereditaments and appurtenances
 to have and to hold the said premises above particularly mentioned and
 described to the said party of the second part - his and assigns
