 bargain sell and convey unto the said Henry J. Lewis
 his heirs and assigns forever the following described real
 estate, situated lying and being in County of Santa Rosa
 State of Florida to wit: Six (6) acres to be laid off in
 a square in the North East Corner of the North half of the
 Antonia Molano Grant lying on the Mateo of the Bay at
 Mary S. Halvay - Together with the improvements thereon and
 the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or
 in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the said
 above described premises unto the said Henry J. Lewis and
 to his heirs and assigns forever, free from all exemption or
 homestead right or claim of us the said grantor or if any
 such right or claim we possess. And I the said grantor
 for myself and my heirs do covenant with the said grantee his
 heirs and assigns that the said real estate is free from any
 lien or encumbrance in law or equity and that the said
 grantor shall and will warrant and by their presents
 forever defend the said premises unto the said grantee his
 heirs and assigns ^{against} the claims of all and every person or
