Brown Trustees in Trust for the uses and purposes hereinafter mentioned, all of the County and State aforesaid, of the second part for and in consideration of the love and favor for the cause of Church and from an earnest desire to promote his heritage on earth, do give and grant and by these presents convey unto the said party of the second part and to their successors Trustees in Trust for the uses and purposes herein after mentioned, all the following described piece or parcel of land lying and being situated in the State of Florida County of Santa Rosa and within the Village of Bagdad and known and described as per plan of said Village as follows to-wit: Lot No. Two (2) in Block No. Fourteen (14) fronting on Fourth Street one hundred and twenty five (125) feet and an overhang that one hundred and thirty five (135) feet according to the plan or map of Bagdad drawn by Lee and Davison and on file in the Office of Simpson and Company. Said lot being a part of Section Fifteen (15) Township one (1) North of Range Twenty Eighth (28) West together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
