P. Ollinger his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns the following described personal property to wit: Six (6) Log Carts and Eleven (11) Yokes (2 wheel) of work oxen said Carts being described as follows: viz: all of them respectively having Iron Axles with 7 ft wheels and 5 inch on tire. Said oxen described thus: they being described into four (4) Teams: one of which is known as the Chas Thompson Team (purchased by me from Chas Thompson) and consist of 2 yoke (4 head) & being driven by one Code Thompson, another of which is known as the McCarther Team (purchased by me from McCarther) consisting of 3 yoke (6 head) & now being driven by W. A. Wolf another known as the Jeff Philips Team (purchased by me from him) & now being driven by Jeff Philips. Consisting of 3 yoke (6 head) another of which is known as the Ferris Cobb Team consisting of 3 yoke (6 head) & now being driven by J. P. Ollinger - all of which said Oxen & Carts are now owned by me and engaged by me in my loggin business at Mound
