

The entire length of said Rail Road from the City of Pensacola to the Apalachicola River and have selected the following tracts or parcels of land hereinafter described and embraced in the said grants of twenty thousand acres for miles and which were granted to the State of Florida by acts of Congress of September 28, 1850, and which are now to be used for the line of the Pensacola and Atlantic Rail Road Company as aforesaid (and not otherwise reserved and appropriated), according to the plan of the survey thereof filed with the Trustees of the National Improvement Fund, and which are situated in the Counties of Walton, Santa Rosa, and Escambia, State of Florida to-wit:

- 3-1-17 The East half of the South East quarter of Section Twelve in Township one North Range Twenty first West
- 3-25 The South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Thirteen in Township one North Range Twenty first West
- 1-27 The South West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Thirteen in Township one North Range Twenty first West
- 2-28 The North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Thirteen in Township one North Range Twenty first West
- 5-29 The North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section Thirteen and the East one of Section Thirteen in Township one North Range Twenty first West

2-31 all of Section Thirteen in Township one North Range Twenty first West, containing in the aggregate three hundred and thirty and thirty-four hundredths acres.

Now therefore know all men by these presents that the undersigned, the Trustees of the National Improvement Fund of the State of Florida in consideration of the provisions and in conformity with the act of the Legislature approved March 21, 1851, have given, granted, and conveyed and by these presents do give grant and convey unto the said Pensacola and Atlantic Rail Road Company and its successors and assigns forever the tracts of land hereinafore mentioned and described to have and to hold the said lands unto the said Pensacola and Atlantic Rail Road Company and its successors and assigns forever.

Intestimony whereof the said Trustees have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals, and have caused the seal of the Department of Agriculture of the State of Florida to be hereunto affixed at the Capital in the City of Tallahassee on this the twenty-second day of November, A. D. One thousand eight hundred and ninety
