Certificate of all to whom their presents shall come. Granting
No. 12963 } Whereas Ebenezer H. Skinner of Escambia County Florida
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a
certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said
Ebenezer H. Skinner according to the provisions of the act of
Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled an act making further
provisions for the sale of the Public Lands and the also supple-
mental thereto for the South West quarter of the 7th west quarter
and the North West quarter of the South West quarter of section
thirty-four in Township five north of Range twenty nine West
of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing seventy
nine acres and ninety two hundredths of an acre according
to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to
the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which said tract
has been purchased by the said Ebenezer H. Skinner.

Now know ye that the United States of America, in consideration
of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of
Congress in such case made and provided have given
and granted and by their presents do give grant unto
the said Ebenezer H. Skinner and to his heirs, the said
tract above described. It have and to hold the same
together with all the rights, privileges, immunities
and appurtenances of what soever nature, thereunto belonging
unto the said Ebenezer H. Skinner and to his heirs and assigns forever
In testimony whereof Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America
have caused this letter to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed
Given under my hand at the City of Washington the fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and seventy eight and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and
fourteenth -
