Know all men by their presents: that the Board of Education of Florida under an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida entitled an Act to Establish a Uniform System of Common School and a University approved January 20 1869 and the present Constitution of said State for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and Twenty five Cents for each to them in hand paid by W Waller of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida have granted bargain and sold and do by their presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said W Waller and his heirs and assigns forever the following described Lands to wit:

The North East Quarter of the North East quarter of Section Sixteen (16) in Township One (1) North of Range Twenty Eight (28) West containing Forty (40) acres and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida to have and to hold the said Lands unto the said W Waller and his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof the members of said Board have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals and have caused the Seal of the Department of Agriculture of the State of Florida to be hereunto affixed at the Capitol in the City of Tallahassee on this the Sixteenth day of February AD Eighteen hundred and ninety
