To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting: Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a copy of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida, which it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862

to secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of William L. Cooley has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the East half of the North East quarter and the North West quarter of the North East quarter and the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section twenty six Township four North of Range twenty seven West of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing one hundred and fifty three acres and eighty hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the Survey of the said land, returned to the General Office by the Surveyor General. And know ye that there is, therefore granted by the United States unto the said William L. Cooley the tract of Land above described: to have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto unto the said William L. Cooley and to his heirs and assigns forever
