Pray his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever the following described property to-wit: The North East quarter (N.E. 1/4) of Section Twenty Two (22) in Township Five (5) North of Range Twenty Nine (29) West containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less and being in the County of Santa Rosa and State of Florida, together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, free from all exemptions and rights of homestead and I covenant that I am well seized of the said property and have a good right to convey the same, that it is free of all incumbrances and that my heirs, executors and administrators the said grantee his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns in the quiet and peaceable possession and enjoyments thereof against all persons lawfully claiming the same shall and will forever warrant and defend.
