

machinery, tools, fuel and material now used or
 acquired in the constructing, operating, repairing or
 replacing of the said railroad or any part thereof.
 And also all other lands of the Pensacola and Atlantic
 Railroad Company with; all the lands donated
 or granted to the Company under and by virtue of
 certain acts of the Congress of the United States of America
 and of the legislature of the State of Florida, amounting to
 about four million acres or thereabouts, including the
 lands that have been located, and the title to which have
 been secured and that are now unsold, lying in
 the Counties of Escambia, Santa Rosa, Walton, Holmes,
 Washington, Jackson, Calhoun, Liberty, Gadsden, Leon,
 Matula, Jefferson, Madison, Taylor, Lafayette,
 and Hamilton or elsewhere, amounting in the aggre-
 gate to about one million eight hundred and sixty
 thousand acres, more or less; and also all the
 remaining lands to which the company is entitled
 or may hereafter secure under said acts of Congress
 and of said legislature of Florida, the title to which
 is not formally secured, but is in progress of adjust-
 ment, being the remainder of the four million acres
 and amounting to about two million acres
 thereabout, by the same more or less, Reference
 is made to the bill of complaint and the decree
 in said case for the further description of said lands
 subject to the lien of the first mortgage upon said
 line of railroad and appurtenant property, real
 and personal bearing date the first day of August
 1881 made to Edmund D Randolph and John L
 Cadwalader as trustees, the latter having been
 added as additional trustee and also subject
 to the lien of the land grant mortgage upon said
 lands and rights to land bearing the date the first
 day of April 1884 made to Edmund D Randolph and
 John L Cadwalader as trustees and to each of them

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And whereas on the 4th day of May 1891 at said
 time and place, and in pursuance of said notice
 given by said publication as required by said decree
 the said Master Commissioners offered said premises
 real, personal and mixed rights and franchises for
 sale to the highest bidder at public auction as aforesaid
 without appraisement or the right of redemption,
 subject to the mortgage aforesaid, and thereupon
 Edmund D Randolph as trustee having complied
 with the conditions, provisions and
 requirements of said decree to enable him to bid
 for the same, did offer and bid therefor the sum
 of \$250,000 and he being the highest and best bidder
 therefor, and no person or persons offering to bid
 any other or larger sum than the said Master Commissioners
