

in the which mortgage John L. Caldwell
 was afterwards added as an additional
 trustee, and subject also to the lien of a
 certain other mortgage or deed of trust
 known as the land grant mortgage,
 executed by the Pensacola & Atlantic Railroad
 Company unto Edmund Randolph and John
 Caldwell as trustees, bearing date the
 1st day of April 1884, to secure the payment of
 Bonds to the amount of \$1,000,000 covering the
 land grant and lands of said Company, not
 covered by said first mortgage.

Herby conveying unto the grantee
 above named all of the premises real
 personal and mixed property, rights and
 franchises, herein before described as fully
 and completely as I may lawfully do
 under the authority aforesaid, free, clear and
 discharged of all rights, estate, lien and
 equity of redemption in or to the premises
 real, personal and mixed property, rights
 and franchises so sold and hereby conveyed
 and every or any part thereof of the defendant
 to said firm and of all persons claiming or to
 claim under said defendant since the
 date of filing of said bill, except as herein before
 specified, and without relief from any
 exemption, valuation, appraisement or
 redemption laws.
