

franchises exemption and privileges pertaining
 to said line of railroad and the road bed, tracks
 right of way, culverts, bridges, trestles, fences, depots,
 station houses, machine shops and other buildings, and
 the several lots pieces and parcels of ground on
 which the same are erected, forming part of said
 railroad and also all engines, locomotives, and
 tenders, passenger, baggage, freight, work cars and
 all other rolling stock, machinery, tools, fuel and
 materials now used or acquired in the constructing
 operating, repairing or replacing of the said railroad
 by any future charter, and also all other lands of the
 Peoria and Atlantic Railroad Company to which
 all the lands donated or granted to the Company
 under and by virtue of the certain acts of the
 Congress of the United States of America and
 of the Legislature of the State of Florida amounting
 to about four million acres or thereabout, includ-
 ing the lands thereon have been located, and titles to
 which have been secured and there are now unsecured
 lying in the Counties of Escambia, Santa Rosa, Walton,
 Holmes, Washington, Jackson, Calhoun, Liberty, Gadsden,
 Leon, Washulla, Jefferson, Madison, Taylor, Lafayette
 and Hamilton or elsewhere, amounting in the
 aggregate to about one million eight hundred and
 sixty thousand acres, more or less, and also all
 the remaining lands to which the Company is
 entitled or may hereafter secure under said acts
 of Congress and of said Legislature of Florida, the
 title to which is not formerly secured, but is
 in process of adjustment, being the remainder
 of the said four million acres and amounting to
 about two million acres thereabout, but the
 same more or less. Reference being made to
 the bill of Complaint and the deors in said
 case for a more particular description of said
 land. And also, all the remaining lands
 to which the Company is entitled or may
 hereafter secure under said Acts of Congress
 and of said Legislature of Florida, the title to which
 is not formerly secured, but is in process of
 adjustment, being the remainder of the said four
 million acres and amounting to about two
 million acres, or thereabout, but the same
 more or less. Together with all and singular the
 tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances, rights
 belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto,
 excepting however from the lands conveyed as aforesaid certain
 lands which have heretofore been sold and conveyed under
 pursuant to the provision of the land grant Mortgage aforesaid, and
 which were expressly excepted from said sale on the 11th day of May 1854.
