To have and to hold the premises, property, rights, franchises and estate hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed with all and singular the recessions, remainders, reversion, income, profits, privileges and appurtenances now or hereafter belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto unto the said Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company the grantee herein named, its successors and assigns forever.

And do subject nevertheless to the lien of a certain mortgage or deed of trust known as the first mortgage executed by said Peasacola and Atlantic Railroad Company to Edmund D Randolph as trustee, bearing date the 1st day of August, 1881 to secure the payment of bonds to the amount of \$3,000,000 covering the railroad land property of said Company, and which mortgage John L Cadwalader was afterwards added as an additional trustee, and subject also to the lien of a certain other mortgage or deed of trust known as the land grant mortgage executed to Edmund D Randolph and John L Cadwalader as trustees bearing date April 1, 1884, to secure the payment of bonds to the amount of \$1,000,000 covering said land grant and lands of said Company not covered by the first mortgage.

The deed of conveyance is however, without any covenants or warranty, express or implied upon the part of the said grantor.
