State of Florida, Know all men by these presents  
 County of Santa Rosa that I Archibald S Lindsey of said  
 State County, for and in consideration  
 of one dollar to me in hand paid by Joseph Ollinger  
 of said State County, the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged & confessed, and in consideration further  
 the premises herein after mentioned, have given  
 bargained & sold and by these presents do give,  
 bargain, sell & deliver unto said Ollinger his heirs  
 Executors, Administrators & assigns the following  
 goods & chattels to wit: Ten (10) head of Stock Cattle  
 five (5) head of which are branded (B L) and  
 marked thus: C in one ear, & swallow fork in  
 other - (3) head of which are also marked as the  
 foregoing but unbranded, and (2) head of which  
 are marked thus: C in one ear & trap split  
 in the other, & unbranded, Also (2) head of morn  
 sters: one being in color Red & white pided, & named  
 Bright & the other white & Red speckled & named Lep  
 All of said Stock now being owned by me & being all  
 owned by me, & the same now ranging at Black  
 Hammock in Santa Rosa County Florida,  
 Do now and to hold said described property unto  
 said Joseph Ollinger his heirs Executors Administrators  
 & assigns to his heirs use & behoof forever,  
 And I the said Archibald S Lindsey conveying the  
 said property is unincumbered, that I own & have  
 good right to sell & dispose of the same, and  
 that I will warrant & protect the same unto  
 said Ollinger his heirs Executors Administrators  
 & assigns against the lawful claims & demands of  
 any & all persons whomsoever,  
 Now the above instrument is intended as a  
 mortgage & is given unto said Ollinger in order  
 the better to secure him in the payment of a debt  
 due from said Lindsey to & to him as follows:  
 That whereas said Lindsey is indebted to him for  
 a certain Boat called the Queen Victoria and is also  
 indebted on other acct in the sum of \$33<sup>00</sup> and has  
 this day executed his certain promissory note unto said  
 Joseph Ollinger for an amount covering a part of said  
 boat indebtedness viz. in the sum of \$100<sup>00</sup> & said other acct  
 above mentioned of \$33<sup>00</sup> total \$133<sup>00</sup> the amt of said  
 note which said note is payable on or before six (6)  
 months after date with int (10%) for and interest for  
 annum from date, know then that if said note  
 is well & truly paid when the same becomes due accor-  
 ding to the line thereof then this instrument to be  
 null & void, else of full force & virtue, It being  
 agreed that in the event of a foreclosure of said  
 mortgage, said Lindsey shall pay unto said Ollinger  
 or his assigns their costs & reasonable attorney
