that was Wm Hoop and Elizabeth

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do  
hereby sell convey and grant unto the Louisville  
and Nashville Railroad Company for the purpose  
of building and operating a Depot, its successor  
David assigns forever, the following described  
property to wit: One acre of ground in Sandoval  
County, State of Florida, lying on the north side  
of the Pole Division of the L. & N. R. R. beginning  
at a stake in the north Right of Way line  
of the Railroad which stake is fifty feet  
from the center of track and 664 feet East of  
Mile post 666, running thence Eastwardly  
parallel to the right road and fifty feet distant  
there from 435 feet, thence northwardly at right  
angles to the railroad 100 feet thence westwardly  
parallel to the railroad 435 feet thence southwardly  
on a line at right angles to the railroad 100 feet to
