Geo. A. Creary of said State and County for & in consideration
of one dollar to me in hand paid by L. F. West of said State and
County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed
have given, granted, bargained and sold and by their presents do
give, grant, bargain sell unto the said West the following personal
property known & described as follows, one hundred & thirty head
of Cattle more or less, the same now being in the Range, with
Henry Prays, Cattle and Pond located in the County of Santa Rosa &
State of Florida, the same being in my name, as recorded
& being all the Cattle in my possession, except two
young Bulls, & two Milk Cows, To have & to hold said
property to the said West his Executors, Administrators &
assigns to his & their use & behoof forever. And I
the said Geo. A. Creary Command to warrant & protect
the title to said property unto the said West his Executors
Administrators & assigns against the lawful Claims
& demands of any & all persons whomsoever.
Now the above instrument is intended as a Mortgage
& is given to the said West in order to secure him
in the payment of a certain Note given March 14th 1892
described as follows. Six (6) months after date, with
10% interest per annum for the sum of One Thousand
Dollars (\$1000.00) Now then if said note with interest
is paid at maturity then this obligation to be null &
Void else of full force & virtue, & in case of foreclosure
said Creary agrees to pay full reasonable costs of
foreclosure, Given under my hand & seal this 7th day of
