County of Santa Rosa } J. M. F. Woodward of said State County,  
for and in consideration of one dollar  
to me in hand paid by Joseph Ollinger of said State  
County, and further more, in consideration of the premises  
herein after named, have given, bargained, sold &  
delivered and by these presents do give bargain sell  
& deliver unto said Ollinger his Executors, Adminis-  
trators & assigns, the following goods & chattels to wit:  
Eight (8) head of Beef Cattle, described as follows viz: (2) six  
year olds branded thus (9) figure nine on right hip &  
marked crop, under bit & over bit in right ear, & over bit  
in left ear, & of the other six (6) head, there are (2) three  
year olds, (2) four year olds & 2 barren cows, all of  
said six head being branded thus (6) figure six  
on right hip & marked crop under bit & over bit in  
right ear and under bit in left ear, all of said  
described property now being in Santa Rosa County  
Florida and on the range at my place near  
Holt Station, - Also (75) seven five Yellow Pine  
Saw logs branded thus N X N the same being now  
cut and in said State County & near my said place  
near Holt Station, To have & to hold said property  
unto said Ollinger his his Executors, administrators  
& assigns to his & their use & behoof forever,  
And I the said M. F. Woodward declare that said property  
is unincumbered, that I am owner of & have good  
right to sell same and that I will warrant & protect  
the title to the same unto said Ollinger against the  
lawful claims & demands of any & all persons whomsoever.  
Now the above instrument is intended as a mortgage  
and is given to the said Ollinger in order the better to  
secure him in the payment of certain amounts due  
to him from me as follows: the sum of \$39<sup>35</sup> the  
day advanced to me - and also the sum of \$433<sup>51</sup>  
incurred by me previous to this date. The conditions  
of said Mortgage are these: that if said Woodward shall  
well & truly deliver said cattle to the Butcher in the town  
of Milton Fla, (Mrs. J. J. Ingram) by last of June 1892 (date of  
which, to said butcher as hereby permitted) and apply the proceeds
