Agreement
C. C. Blocker
to
Parodi & Co.

This agreement made and entered into this the 25th day of May 1892 by between C. C. Blocker and Parodi & Co both of Saint Rosa County Florida. Witnesses:
That said C. C. Blocker agrees to furnish to said Parodi & Co and deliver to Magnolia Broom from two to three hundred logs per month, more or less, and Parodi & Co agree to receive them and pay for them at the following scale of prices to wit: For logs measuring 16 or 17 ft long 5 1/2^c per ft; for 18, 19, or 20 ft long 6^c per ft and for 21 to 24 ft long 6 1/2^c per foot. It is furthermore agreed that Parodi & Co will advance to C. C. Blocker in order to enable him to carry out the contract fifty (50^c) cents per log - when portion of logs are on the banks ready to be rolled in, C. C. Blocker shall give notice of same to Parodi & Co who will send their agent to camp and brand said logs (this to be once a month or sooner) and on report of said agent the advance will be made to said C. C. Blocker in accordance with number of same, for which advance said Parodi & Co shall have a lien upon all logs and said Parodi & Co are hereby authorized in case of any accident to said Blocker or when poverty may deem it necessary for their security to take possession of said logs and get same to market at the expense of said Blocker. That said Blocker agrees to pay the interest of Eight per cent (8%) per annum
