

Contract  
 W. F. Milligan  
 to  
 Parodi Co.

This agreement made and entered into the the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1896 and between W. F. Milligan and Parodi Co. both of Santa Rosa County Florida witnesses that said W. F. Milligan agrees to furnish to said Parodi Co. and deliver to the Boom at the mouth of Yellow River seven thousand pine logs, more or less, and Parodi Co. agrees to receive and pay for them at the following scale of price to viz: For logs measuring 16 or 17 ft. Cub. average 60<sup>cts</sup> per Cft.; for 18 or 19 ft. 6 1/4<sup>cts</sup>; for 20 or 21 ft. 6 1/2<sup>cts</sup> per ft. and for 22 or 24 ft. 6 3/4<sup>cts</sup>. It is furthermore agreed that Parodi Co. will advance to said W. F. Milligan in order to enable him to carry on the contract (70<sup>cts</sup>) seventy cents per log on the first three thousand logs and 60<sup>cts</sup> per log on the remainder four thousand when portions of logs are on the Bank of the River ready to be rolled in. W. F. Milligan shall give when of same to Parodi Co. who will send their agent to count and brand said logs, and on report of said agent the advance will be made to said Milligan, in accordance of number of same, for which advance said Parodi Co. shall have a lien upon all said logs, and said Parodi Co. are hereby authorized in case of any accident to said Milligan or whenever they may deem it necessary for their security to take possession of said logs and get the same to market at the expense of said Milligan. It is also agreed that W. F. Milligan shall drive or have said logs driven to the Boom at the mouth of Yellow River as soon as water will admit said logs and deliver them for inspection to such Inspector as said Parodi Co. shall select. Said logs however not to be deemed delivered until the same shall have been inspected & delivered to said Parodi Co. or their agent to receive them and when so made, final payment of same logs will be made to said Milligan. Now it is furthermore agreed and understood that all logs irrespective of length or cubic measurement not measuring (13) inches in diameter shall not be deemed bargained or sold at the price above mentioned, but shall be set apart the price to be paid for them subject to such agreement as said Milligan and said Parodi Co. shall agree upon. And said W. F. Milligan covenants that said logs are taken from lands to which he has good right to take same and that the same are unincumbered, and that he will defend said Parodi Co. against any
