 the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20<sup>00</sup>) lawful money  
 of the United States, in hand paid, the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bar-  
 gained, sold, alienated, remise, released,  
 conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents  
 do grant, bargain, sell, alienate, remise, release,  
 convey, and confirm unto the said party of the  
 second part, his heirs and assigns, all that piece  
 of, and parcel of land lying, and being situate in  
 Santa Rosa County, State of Florida, to wit, Eight  
 acres of land lying in the South East part of the O.  
 Molina grant, as follows; commencing thirty five  
 chains, sixty one and nine tenths links, (35.61.9 ch.)  
 from original corner on Bay, on line between the O.

 West, on old line, twelve chains, sixty four and nine
